

Pre-Health Internships

Medical, Scientific Research, Public Health, & Veterinary

Many internship and research opportunities are available in the area of pre-health and scientific research in a wide variety of fields. This brief guide will get you started on your search.

Medical Internships

Internships in the field of medicine are primarily available in the areas of patient care or medical research. Internships in patient care are often volunteer positions and involve assisting or shadowing doctors, nurses, and technicians in the diagnosis and treatment of patients. These opportunities are widely available and most often can be obtained by contacting a hospitals volunteer office. Something to remember is that some volunteer positions available at hospitals are in support staff positions and with little or no interaction with doctors and patients. To avoid positions like this, be sure to ask what your specific duties will be as a volunteer.

Scientific Research Internships

The other, broader areas of medical and scientific internships are research internships. Unlike patient care internships, many research internships are paid internships. Scientific research internships can be found at most colleges, medical schools, research hospitals, government agencies, and in research companies. Aside from the numerous research opportunities offered at Hopkins (both at Homewood & the Medical School), one of the best places to search for a medical research internship is at the National Institute of Health (NIH) and the US Department of Health & Human Services. Both of these have great internship programs in place for undergraduate students.

Public Health Internships

The field of public health is constantly growing and becoming increasingly important in today's world. As this happens, there are increasingly more internships available in this field. Public health internships are available in a variety of areas such as formation of public health policy and legislation, research, lobbying, education/awareness programs, and publishing. Internships in public health are both paid and unpaid, however, the current trend is that research internships are paid while many of the policy, education, and lobbying internships are unpaid (only true for undergraduates). Most public health internships are available in the government, non-profit organizations, and at schools of public health throughout the country.

Public Health Internships

Similar to those pursuing a career in medicine, if you are considering going into the field of veterinary medicine there are many internship opportunities available to you as well. Majorities of internships in this field are located at zoos and entail assisting zookeepers and veterinarians with feeding and caring for the animals. In addition to the primary job of taking care of animals, many of these internships have an additional educational component ranging from taking a class to doing independent research projects.

Overall, the trend with veterinary internships for undergraduates is that they are unpaid, although a very limited number of paid internships are available. This is largely because most paid internships are reserved for students in veterinary school, so if you need a paid internship start your search early or consider other options for funding such as applying for internship grants from the Second Decade Society.

The first place to start looking for a veterinary internship is Handshake's Job and Internship board, which you can access through your Handshake Account. Another place to search is the employment section of websites for zoos. Many zoos have some form of an internship program in place already and advertise these programs on their websites.
