The **Governor's Summer Internship Program (GSIP)** fellowship introduces Maryland's "best and brightest" college students to the rewards and challenges of working within Maryland state government. Students are paid a stipend of \$3,000.

THE FELLOWSHIP HAS 4 COMPONENTS:

[Experience]

Intern at a government agency full-time under the mentorship of a senior-level professional

[Exploration]

Attend seminars to strengthen your understanding of state government and policy making

[Exposure]

Attend meetings, events, and field trips to connect with Maryland's leaders

[Practice]

Work together in groups to put your knowledge and skills into practice, developing a policy analysis and recommendation to present to the Governor and cabinet

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Available May 31 - Aug 11, 2017
- Rising Junior or Senior in Fall 2017
- Attending a Maryland institution or current Maryland resident
- GPA 2.7 or above
