The **Maryland Department of Transportation (MDOT) Fellows Program** exposes Maryland's "best and brightest" college students to careers in the state sector within Maryland's integrative transportation system. Students in all majors are placed in full-time assignments in one of MDOT's modals and are mentored by senior-level administrators. With the knowledge gained at their placements, and through seminars, trips, and networking events, fellows research and create a proposal to solve a transportation challenge. Students are paid a \$3,500 stipend.

### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Available June 9 - August 4, 2017
- Rising Junior or Senior in Fall 2017
- Attending a Maryland institution or current Maryland resident
- GPA 2.7 or above
- Available March 31 for interviews
