Attend meetings, events, and field trips to connect with Maryland's leaders

[Practice]

Work together in groups to put your knowledge and skills into practice, designing innovative way to address a challenge facing Maryland

- Available May 31 - August 11, 2017
- Rising Junior, Senior, or Graduate Student in Fall 2017
- Attending a Maryland institution or current Maryland resident
- GPA 2.7 or above
