Glean

Capture

Take live recordings or import audio from lectures, meetings, classroom activities, and brainstorming sessions.

Annotate

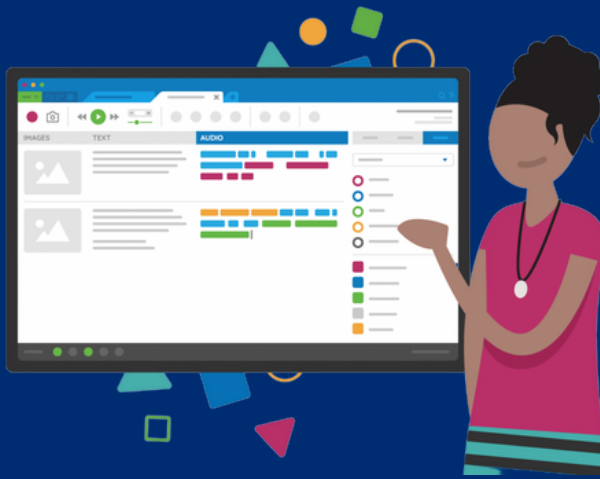
Add layers of meaning to project with color, text, images, presentation slides, and PDF.

Review

Transcribe or summarize your recordings.

Engage

Share your completed project with others, or use it to prepare for an exam. Extract sections of audio and text into a new project.



Livescribe Pen

Record everything you hear, say and write -- while linking your audio recordings to your notes. The pen indexes what you hear at the time of writing, converting what you have written into an interactive PDF file.
