WHAT

3MT® is an academic research communication competition developed by The University of Queensland (UQ), Australia in 2008. Doctoral students have three minutes – and a single, static PowerPoint slide - to present compelling and engaging talks on their dissertation topic. 3MT empowers students to consolidate their ideas and concisely explain their research discoveries to non-specialist audiences.

Improve your research communication skills and learn how to succinctly describe and present your work – invaluable skills that will give you an important career advantage once you complete your studies. 3MT also provides an outstanding forum to meet your peers and develop long-lasting collaborations.
