Please read through the following Q&A if you have any questions about the formal:

1. How many formal tickets in total will be released and what are the numbers of tickets being distributed to each school?

Ans: This year we are releasing **a total of 500 tickets**. Based on the population of each campus as well as their financial contribution, GRO allocated 400 tickets for Homewood students, 20 tickets for School of Nursing, 80 tickets for both Peabody and School of Education, as shown on the Hopkins

Groups event portal. There will be <u>no more</u> tickets being released once 500 tickets are sold. If you want to secure your ticket(s) to the formal, please be sure to log into your Hopkins Group event portal five minutes before ticket sale time.

2. Are the tickets refundable?

Ans: Yes, you can request a refund for your ticket(s) over Hopkins Groups until **2 days** before the formal. Once you pass the deadline, GRO will no longer process your refund requests. If you pass the refund deadline and have a time conflict with the formal, you can sell your tickets to others who are interested and the new ticket holders will check in to the event using your name.

3. What is the dress code of the event?

Ans: The dress code will be either black tie formal or ethnic formal wear. Ethnic formal wear is encouraged for students from diverse cultural backgrounds. We really appreciate you arriving at the formal in your formal wear.

4. How can I get to the venue?

Ans: You can take the Hopkins shuttle or a cab to get to the Lord Baltimore Hotel. Unfortunately, GRO doesn't provide any transportation between each campus to the venue.

5. What do I need to bring to the spring formal?

Ans: You will need to bring either your government-issued ID or your Hopkins ID with your DOB to check in with our security. Then you will need to scan the QR code to check into the event.

6. Will coat check service be provided?

Ans: Yes if the weather requires it..
