V. Advocacy: Statements Update

- The distribution of statements to the graduate community from the advocathon
 has been delayed due to a request to vet by the admin vetting committee to avoid
 unwanted consequences on the university's federal funding.
- This will be clarified at the meeting on Wednesday to discuss the best approach and next steps.
- SGA reps will be discussing the same statement issue at their meeting.
- The list of demands at the meeting includes knowing who will be vetting the statement and what topics are essential.

VI. Advocacy: Shared Governance Council (KSAS) update by Chris

- Grad students to be welcomed at the next SGC subcommittee on Grad, overview
 of statistics of students who have completed PhD and postdoctoral affairs to
 discuss the graduate course evaluation and KSAS postdoctoral experience
 - 1. Call to add to the agenda and discussion point for the meeting
- Discussions about the federal policy changes that affect the university operation (example of office of federal strategy that focus on hope the university is doing with federal funding) to highlight and harmonize the SGC works and ultimately share stories through statement with the graduate student community via Hub articles and other means to show how the university has positioned itself in making impact

 - 3. In your department, approximately how many students are enrolled in first-year courses?

- Caroline asked how the transition from courses across different years and level may affect responses and can be captured.
- o Arman asked if the survey is focused on MS, PhD, or combined student programs.
- Chris mentioned the survey is focused on PhD for now.
- Satvik asked how Hopkins planned to attend to the overhead cut

 Chris responded that all matters are still in court and going through proper proceedings.
