
Procedures to Receive Blue Jay Family Welcome

 Parent/Guardian Info here (i.e. address, phone and email)
 - Students can "Add Authorized User" or modify/delete an existing user/access levels
- If students are looking to update their Emergency Contact information:
 - Emergency Contact information includes phone, email, and address in addition to the name/relationship


