- **C. Courses with Non-Standard Meeting Times:** Courses with Non-Standard times should plan to follow the closest Standard Time's exam date and time. Examples:
 - a A Monday 2 PM course would follow the M(WF) 1:30 PM exam schedule
 - **b** A Monday 2:30 PM course would follow the M(WF) 3 PM exam schedule
- **D. Make-up Date:** Monday, December 18th, 2pm-5pm will be reserved for make-up exams and resolution of conflicts.

E. Conflicts

- a *Instructors* with conflicting examinations should plan to use the scheduled make-up slot for one of the exams in conflict: **Monday, December 18^h, 2pm-5pm**
 - i If the use of the reserved make-up time is not possible, the instructor should contact their Vice Dean for approval of an alternate date/time. All requests for alternate dates/times must be submitted to the Vice Dean of Education by Friday, September 8th.
 - ii If student polling is necessary to select an alternate date/time, please contact the appropriate Vice Dean for Education. Only the offices of the Vice Deans of Education are permitted to poll students regarding proposed final exam times so as to maintain confidentiality and avoid the possibility of coercion.
 - iii Only after approval is obtained should instructors or departments contact ASENScheduling@jhu.edu to schedule a classroom.
- **b Students** with exam conflicts should contact the respective <u>instructor(s)</u> to make alternative arrangements.
- F. Asynchronous Online Classes: Classes that are meeting asynchronously may schedule an exam in the make-up slot on Monday, December 18th, 2pm-5pm OR may have their students polled to determine a suitable time by contacting the appropriate Vice Dean for Education of their school. Only the offices of the Vice Deans of Education are permitted to poll students regarding proposed final exam times so as to maintain confidentiality and avoid the possibility of coercion. All requests for dates/times must be submitted to the Vice Dean of Education by Friday, September 8th.
