

Subject: Fall 2023 Grading to Open Friday, December 8!

Dear Faculty,

As the primary instructor for a Fall 2023 course in the Whiting School of Engineering or Krieger School of Arts & Sciences, I wanted to inform you that **grading will open this Friday, December 8, 2023** for full term courses! If you also teach a Term 2 Short Course, that grading period will not be open until 12/22/2023.

Grading for Graduating Seniors is due Wednesday, 1/3/2024

Online Grading in SIS will close Wednesday 1/3/2023 for full term courses at 11:59PM. On this date all saved grades will be posted to records, even if they are not posted to registrars.

The above grading period is your opportunity to bulk grade! If you miss this grading window, you will have to individually grade your students via Grade Change Webform. Timely grading is required by the Faculty Handbook: all grades should be submitted 48 hours after the final examination is given.
