• The <u>FIRST Robotics Competition</u> combines the excitement of sport with the rigors of science and technology. High-school student participate under strict rules, limited resources, and an intense six-week time limit, teams of 20 or more students are challenged to raise funds, design a team "brand," hone teamwork skills, and build and program industrial-size ~120 lb.robots to play a difficult field game against like-minded competitors. It's as close to real-world engineering as a student can get. Volunteer professional mentors lend their time and talents to guide each team.
