# WHAT IS THE J-CARD?

The J-Card is the official photo identification and access card for students, faculty, and staff at the Johns Hopkins University. In addition, the J-Card serves as your library card, your meal card, and your door access card for residential halls and many campus buildings.

J-Cash is a prepaid, stored value account that is part of your J-Card and is activated as soon as you make a deposit. J-Cash is the convenient, cashless way to pay for your purchases on and off campus.

The area's most popular local businesses accept J-Cash and you can use it to pay for laundry, vending, printing and copying. See our website at [jcard.jhu.edu](http://jcard.jhu.edu) for a complete listing of locations.



By depositing money on your J-Card, you can use your J-Cash to pay and forget about carrying cash, checks, and credit cards. Parents feel comfortable making deposits knowing it will only be accepted at university-approved locations. Up-to-date balances are available with every receipt and can be viewed on the J-Card Mobile app and at J-Card Online.

# HOW TO DEPOSIT MONEY TO YOUR J-CARD



### Deposit Online

Parents and students can access J-Card Online by going to [jcard.jhu.edu](http://jcard.jhu.edu) and clicking "Deposit J-Cash Online". Log in using your JHED/ISIS credentials and you can:

- Make a deposit by credit/debit card
- View J-Cash balances and transactions
- View and download account statements and transaction history



### Deposit in Person

Deposit machines are installed at many locations across campus - you can easily deposit this way using a credit/debit card. To deposit using cash on campus, use the deposit machine located right outside of the J-Card Office in Garland Hall.



### Deposit by Phone

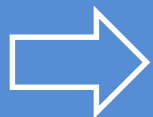
The J-Card Office will accept your confidential credit card information over the phone
